COMPETITORS RULES & CONDITIONS

ALL PARTICIPATING ENTRANTS MUST ABIDE TO THE FOLLOWING

Drivers and passengers must wear long sleeves, appropriate shoes and a crash helmet and be restrained (use seat belts) In ALL EVENTS.

ENTRANTS must have a current drivers licence and will have a stand alone Armband and only those are to be the drivers that participate within the driving events. (Cross Entry is available at \$50.00 to other licensed participants, at scrutineering)

ENTRANTS CARS MUST NOT HAVE PROTRUDING LIMBS AT ANY TIME OF THE EVENT!

BURNOUTS WILL ONLY BE TOLERATED WITHIN THE BURNOUT COMP!

NEW RULES

**Go To Whoa MEANS GO TO WHOA NOT BURNOUTS,
Motakana MEANS MOTAKANA NOT BURNOUTS,
Burnouts MEAN BURNOUTS.**

Burnouts are restricted to the Driving Events area only entrants found doing burnouts outside the Driving Events area will be excluded from the event, no excuses, no exceptions.

ENTRANTS MUST STOP IF A TYRE BLOWS DURING ANY COMPETITION and slowly make their way to the Fire Marshalls.

Continuing to do a burnout after a tyre has blown will incur a 5 point penalty within the Burnout Comp or Risk Exclusion of event at any other time.

No Static Burnouts (this means instant disqualification).

Entrants may leave their tow cars/trailers at the Show Site over night and this is at their risk but security will be on site.

Tow Cars that tow an Entrant vehicle are FREE to park at the Airport but MUST Remain within the designated trailer parking area.

ALL OTHER SUPPORT CARS ARE WELCOME
TO PARK IN PUBLIC CARPARK.

Entrants and Buddies are reminded that they must remain behind all barriers and buffers

Goody Bags will be ready for pickup from the Autofest Office after 10.00am Saturday

Sunday Morning's Supercruise will start at Airport, be there by 8.30 am for a 9.00am start.
